

2017 LETR Incentives

All agencies are responsible for tracking their own fundraising totals and submitting the Special Event Forms and the Fundraising Contribution Form annually no later than January 15th to qualify for incentives.

Conference qualifications change with the costs and location of the conference.

The funds raised to qualify will be adjusted as necessary.

2017 Torch Run Conference Representation in Tennessee:

Fundraising totals are based on the year prior to the conference (i.e. 2016 totals for 2017 conference).

Small Agencies defined as 50 sworn officers. (IACP definition)

Small Agencies raising a total of \$13,000 NET funds within 2 consecutive years (2014 and 2015) may send one representative to conference in 2016. Only one representative may attend every 2 years if utilizing the Small Agency definition.

Agencies over 50 sworn officers (or small agencies may participate annually):

One representative may attend for every \$12,000 NET funds raised for 2016 Conference (2015 totals).

Other LETR incentives received by participants throughout the year may include: Torch Runner shirts, Polar Plunge shirts/hats/incentives based on levels, participant shirts/incentives at many events, and other incentives at the discretion of Special Olympics Kansas.
