

VOLLEYBALL SCOREKEEPING VOLUNTEERS

GENERAL INFORMATION: Check in and out at the Volunteer Registration table. Please notify the Volunteer Registration table if you plan to leave early.

There will be up to 8 courts running at a time. A tournament bracket will be posted with updates on match times and locations.

Each court will have a referee assigned. Your duties will be primarily scorekeeping, but if necessary we may ask you to perform other duties to assist the referee and/or Games Management Team. We make every attempt to have at least 2 scorekeepers per court.

DUTIES:

- The scorekeepers job is to make sure they are paying attention to the referees when points are awarded to certain teams and record the score in the score book.
- They are also responsible for putting the score on the flip score boards so the crowd and teams know what the score is.
- They are also responsible for keeping track of time. Each match will consist of the teams playing the best 2 out of 3 games. Each game will be 10 minutes long for the Level IIB and Level III teams. Unified does not have a time limit.
- Every game will be rally scoring, which means no matter who serves the ball, someone is always awarded a point.
- Each game will be played to 25, unless they play a 3rd game, then it will only be to 15.
- Line Judging- If there are not enough referees, scorekeepers may be asked to assist the referee
 - (1) in determining if the server crosses the line while serving,
 - (2) in determining if the ball lands in or out of the court (the ball touching the line is still considered “in”) and/or
 - (3) by holding on to extra balls and chasing stray balls to keep the game moving along.
- Volunteers will have short breaks in between matches to use restroom or get water. Please remember to return to your post before the next match begins or find a substitute to cover your duties while taking a break.
