Introduction

Welcome to the 2014 Reach Report on the development and growth of Special Olympics.

This report is based on annual Census data collected by thousands of staff and volunteers all over the world who undertake this substantial task every year. Without their efforts it simply would not be possible to put together this important and valuable snapshot of the Special Olympics movement. The Report provides a summary of key programmatic results that were achieved during the course of 2014. By collecting data from all of our Programs across the globe, we are able to see where we are making progress against our 5-year Strategic Plan and also understand where we need to focus more effort if we are to achieve our strategic goals.

Data for the 2014 Reach Report were collected from 221 Special Olympics National/State Programs in 170 countries. The Report is organized to follow the key pillars of our 2011 – 2015 Strategic Plan: Advance Quality Sports and Competitions, Build Communities, Connect Fans and Funds, Develop Movement Leadership and Establish Sustainable Capabilities.

Advance Quality Sports and Competitions

The Movement's Reach: Athlete Growth Data 2009-2014

- Africa had the highest growth rate of any Special Olympics Regions for the third consecutive year.
- Two Regions reported lower athlete numbers: the drop in Europe-Eurasia was due to more accurate reporting¹, while the fall in MENA was mainly due to the fact that there were five fewer Programs accredited in 2014 due to the challenging environment in the Region.

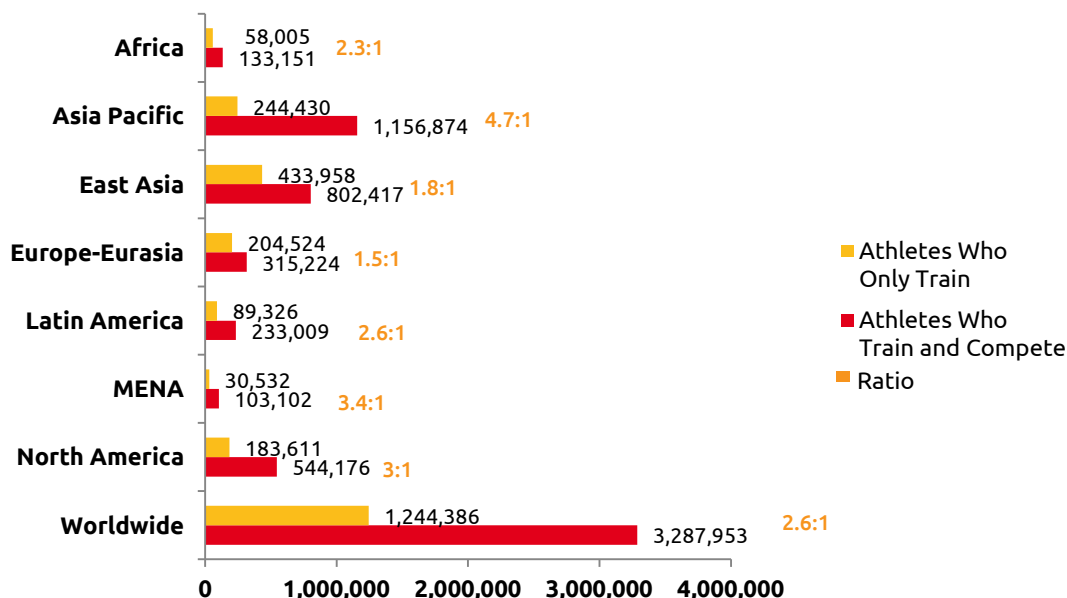

Athlete Participation

- The worldwide ratio of athletes who train and compete vs. athletes who only train fell slightly from 2.7:1 in 2013 to 2.6:1 in 2014.



Coaches

- Asia Pacific Region exhibited the strongest growth in number of coaches with 95% of the increase taking place in SO Bharat.

Competitions

- The Europe-Eurasia Region increased its number of competitions offered by over 100%. This was almost entirely attributable to SO Netherlands which increased the number of competition opportunities reported from 12 in 2013 to 8,000 in 2014.

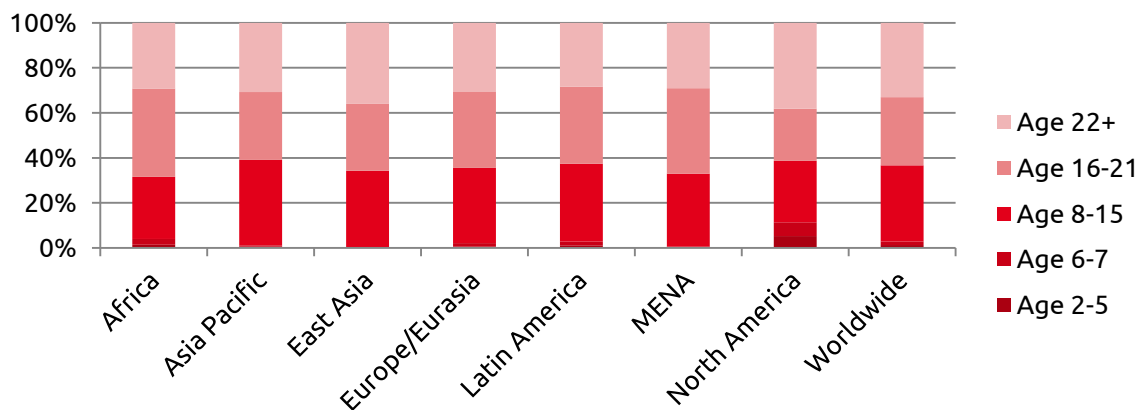

Athlete Demographics – Age and Gender

- In Africa, the 16-21 age group increased from 35.4% of the total in 2013 to 39.3% in 2014, while in North America, athletes aged 2-7 increased from 10.1% to 11.4% of the Region’s total in 2014.

- Special Olympics has a total of 1,777,130 female athletes and 2,755,209 male athletes.

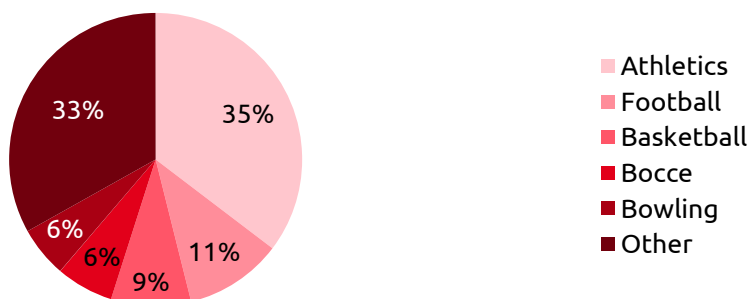

Sports Participation

- Athletics has remained the most popular sport worldwide by far, followed by Football and Basketball on the list of top five sports in each of the seven Regions.
- The list of sport rankings remains mostly unchanged from 2013, however Aquatics replaced Bocce as the #5 sport in Africa and Floor Hockey as the #5 sport in North America.

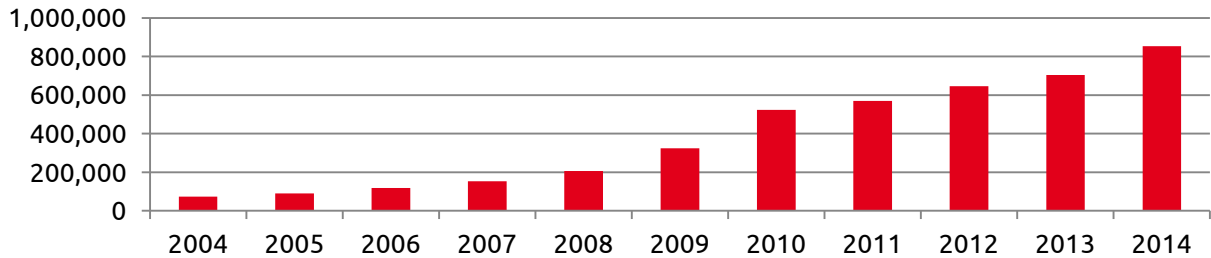

Unified Sports

- In 2014, Unified Sports participation increased by 150,752 Unified athletes and partners.
- This is more than 21% growth in the past year alone and a 7% increase in growth rate from 2012-13.

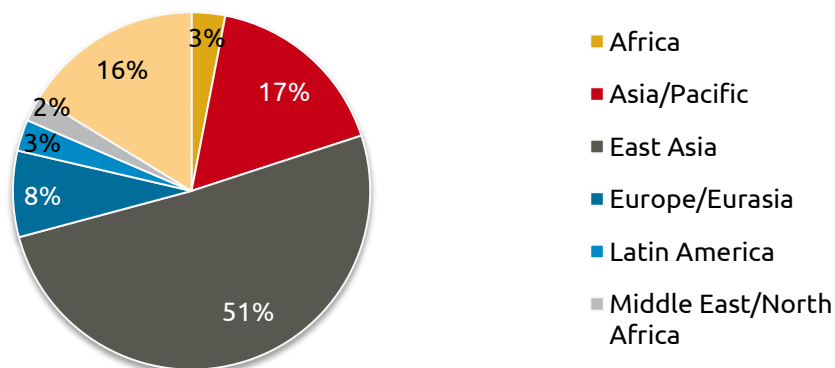
Unified Sports Growth 2004 – 2014

- East Asia continues to lead with 51% of the total number of Unified Sports participants.
- Regionally, Asia Pacific added more than 80,000 participants. The number is driven largely by SO Bharat (India), thanks to support received from the government and ESPN to implement Unified Sports in schools around the country.

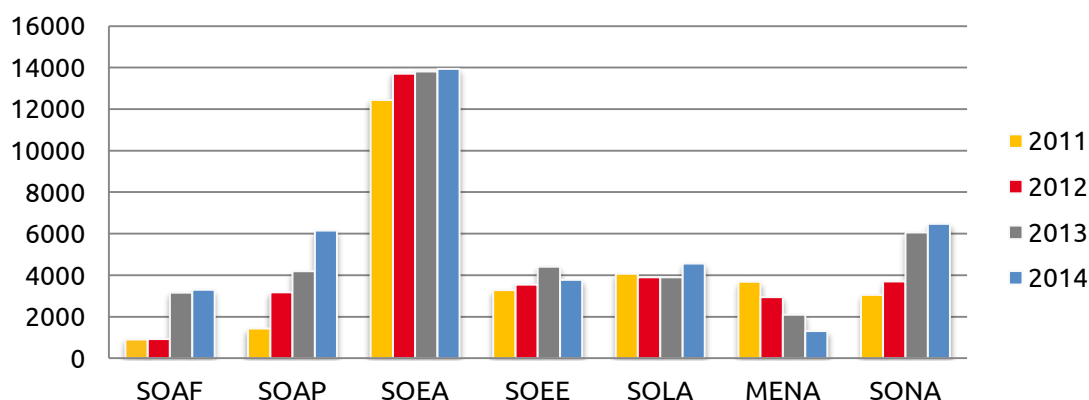
Athletes in a Leadership Role (Including ALPs)

- We continued with a definition of this metric, first introduced in 2012, which recognizes the varied roles that athlete leaders play, both as part of and beyond traditional ALPs programming.
- While the number of Special Olympics athletes in a leadership role has grown year by year, the pace of growth slowed considerably during 2014.
- Five of the seven Special Olympics Regions recorded an increase in athlete leadership participation. Two Regions showed decreases due to more accurate reporting of numbers.

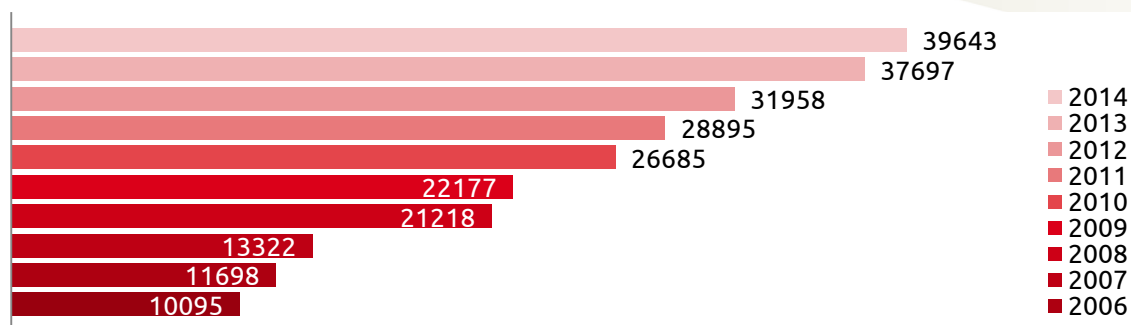

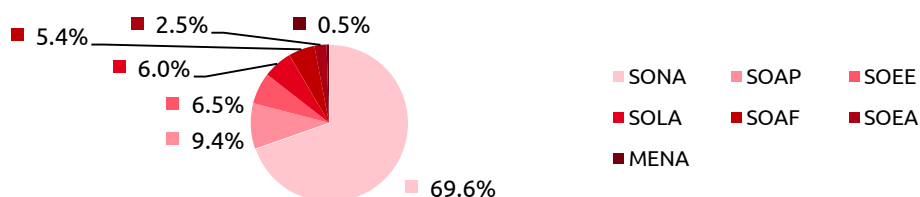

Athletes 2 – 7 Years Old

- In 2014, more than 178,000 children with intellectual disabilities aged 2 – 7 years participated in Special Olympics, an increase of 60.1% over 2013. This number includes two distinct groups. The first group consists of athletes aged 6-7 years who have commenced training in a particular sport, while the second group consists of athletes aged 2-7 who participate in our Young Athletes program.

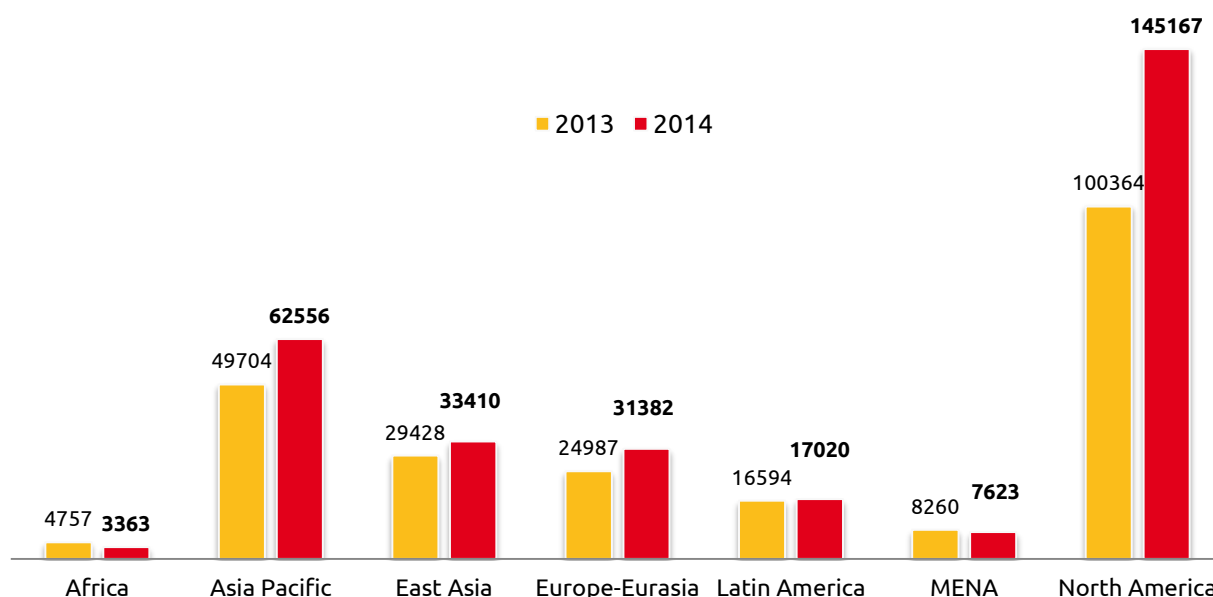

Youth

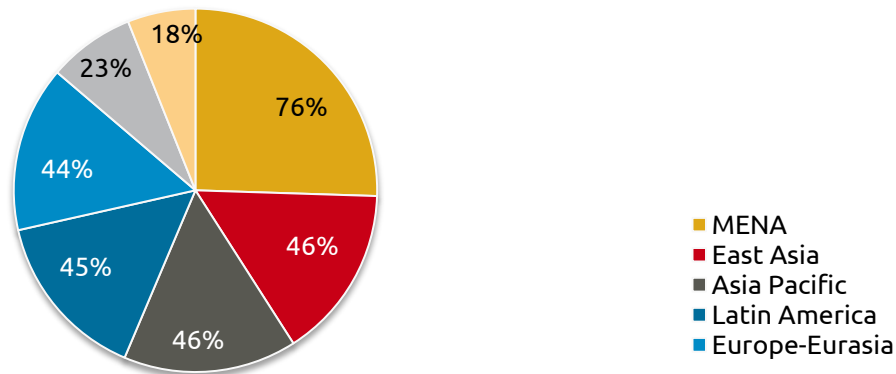
- Youth volunteers are classified as anyone aged between 12 and 25. Overall the number increased by 28.4% to 300,521, with significant increases in North America, Asia Pacific and Europe-Eurasia.

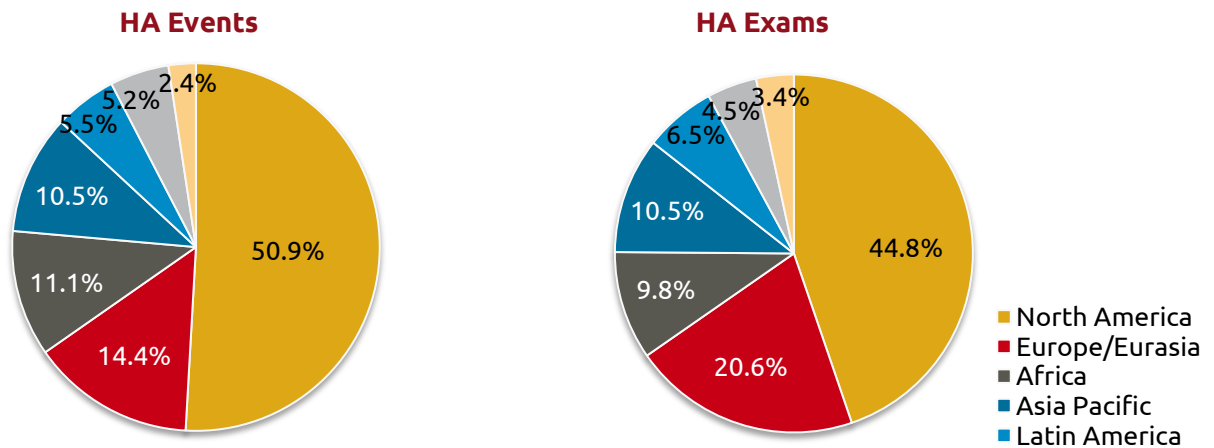

Health

- All seven disciplines of Healthy Athletes conducted 138,775 exams at 831 events.
- 112 Programs (50.7%) from 67 countries in all seven regions conducted exams.
- 46 Programs conducted 33,061 exams in new locations.
- 11.9% of athletes reported mouth pain, 34.1% had obvious, untreated tooth decay, 20.4% reported never having had an eye exam, and 31.9% of adults were obese.
- 20,911 clinical volunteers participated in Healthy Athletes.

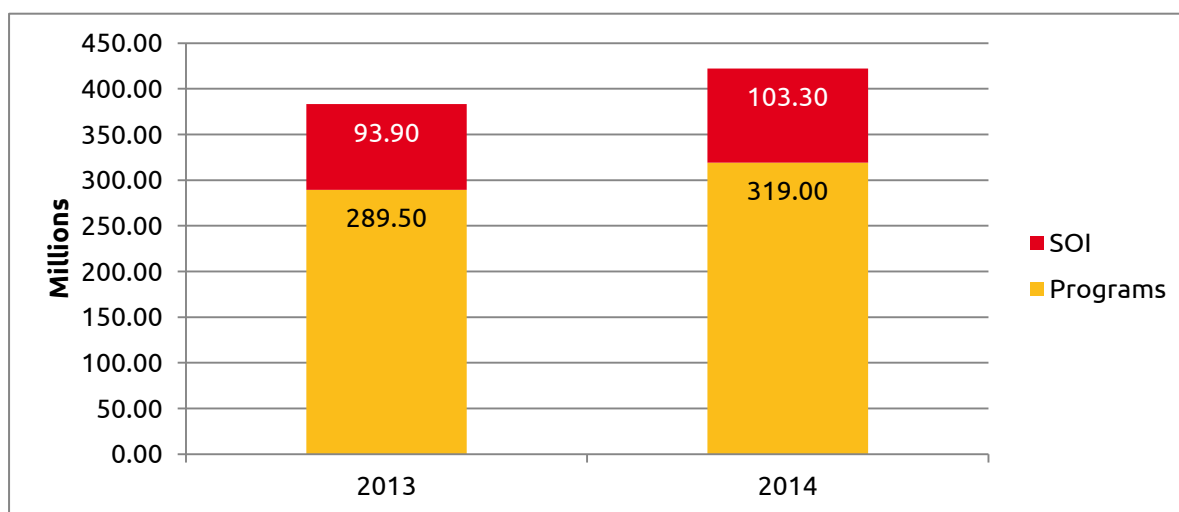
- Trained 6,457 health advocates (families, coaches, athlete leaders) on relevant health topics

- Overall cash and VIK revenues raised by Programs and Special Olympics International (SOI) increased by 10.2% during 2014, from 383.4m in 2013 to 422.3m in 2014.

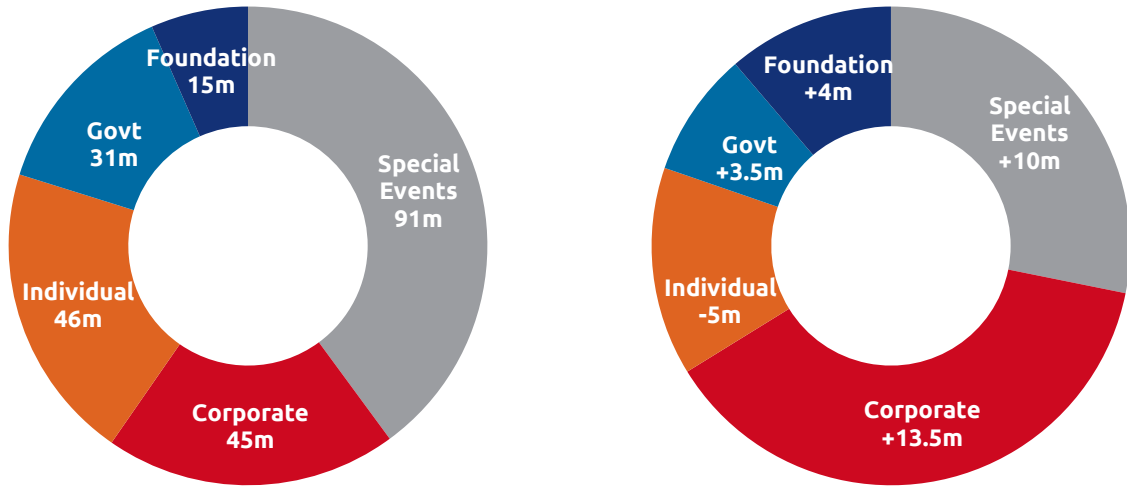

Movement Revenue – Cash

- SOI increased cash revenues by 2.7%, from \$72.8m in 2013 to \$74.8m in 2014.
- There was a 12.9% increase in cash revenue reported by Programs, from \$202m in 2013 to \$228m in 2014, with the strongest growth being in Special Events and Corporate partnerships.



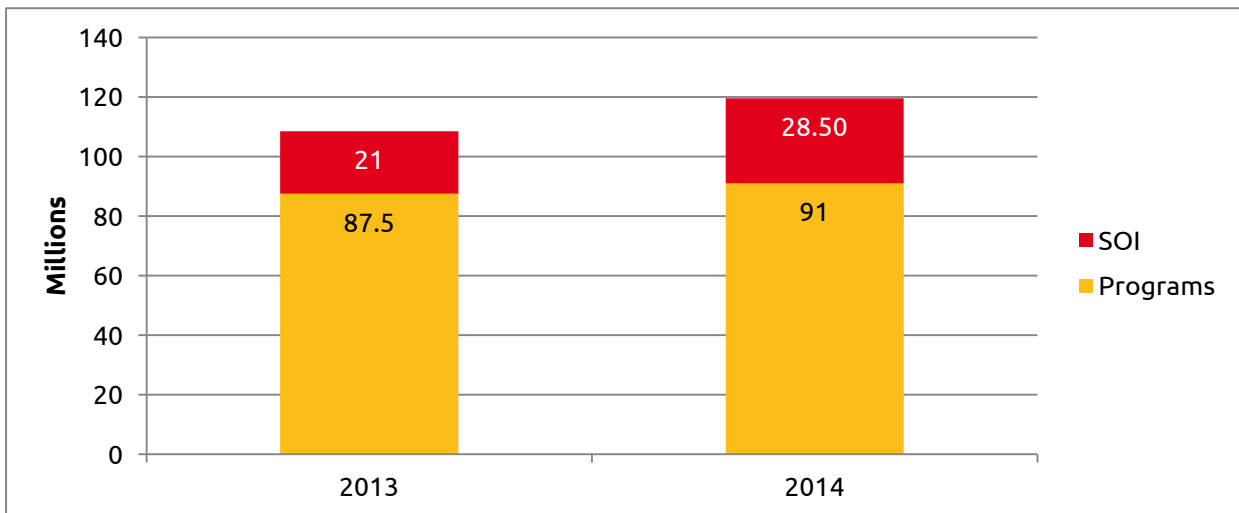
Program Revenue (Cash, excluding VIK) and change compared with 2013 (in millions)

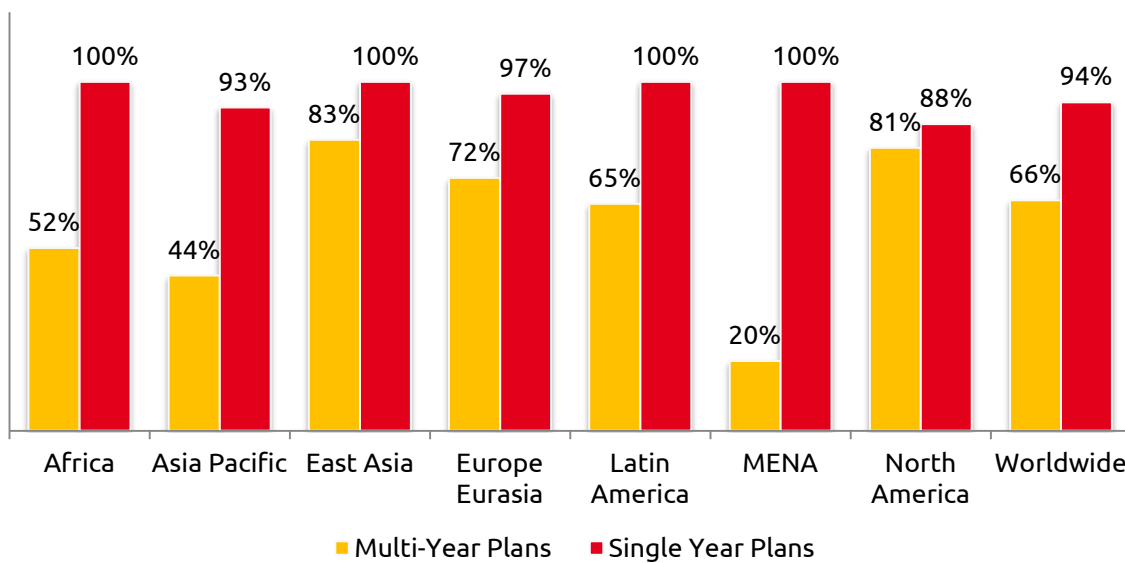
- \$9.7m was raised for Europe-Eurasia, USA and MENA Regional Games during 2014.

Operational Plans

- There was an increase of 15 Programs with a multi-year plan. 146 Programs (66% of all Programs) now have a multi-year plan compared with 60% in 2013.
- There was an increase of 9 Programs with a single-year plan. 208 Programs (94% of all Programs) now have a single-year plan compared with 89% in 2013.



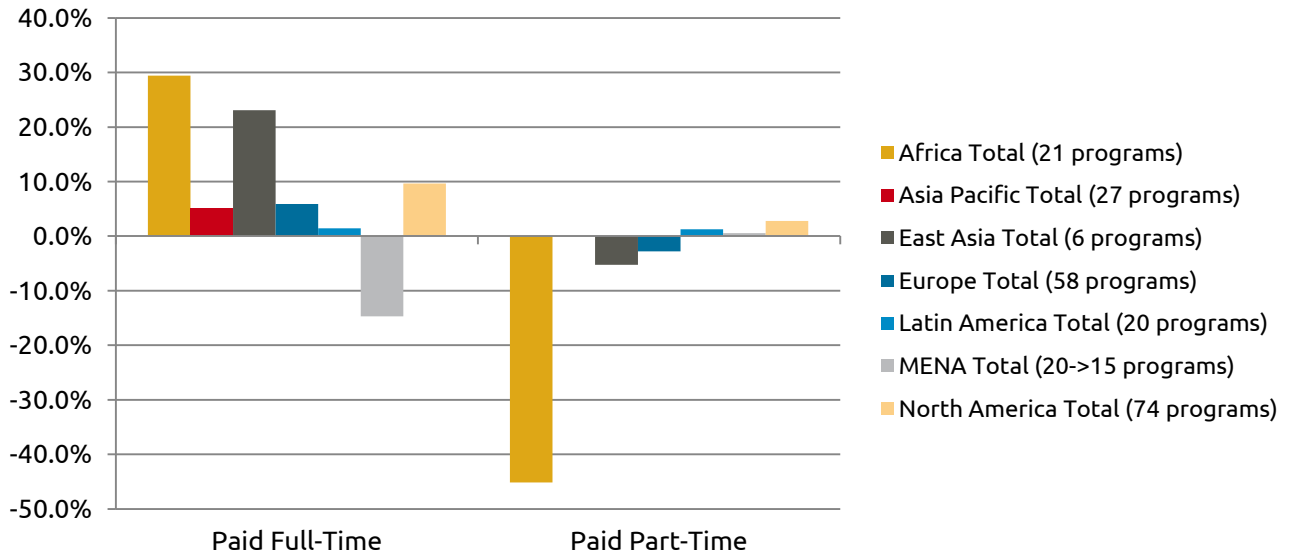

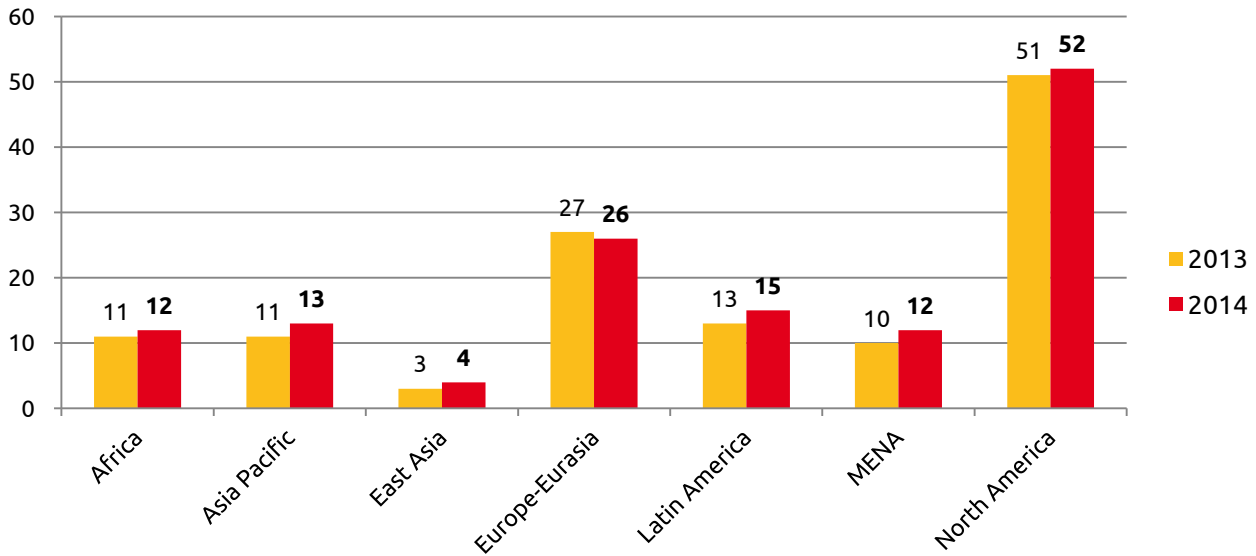

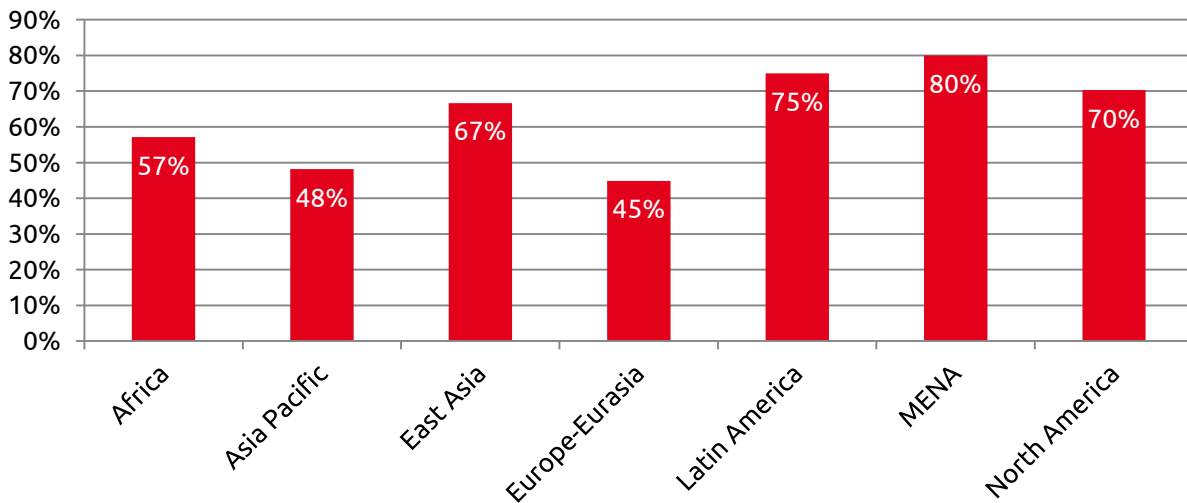

- Traffic to Resources.SpecialOlympics.org, the primary vehicle for knowledge management across the Special Olympics movement, more than doubled to 256,325 users in 2014.
- With 84% of traffic from the North America, the data highlight a need to promote Resources.SpecialOlympics.org more intensively in other Regions, or find other methods to reach these audiences.

Research and Evaluation

Special Olympics continues to conduct and facilitate research and evaluation that advances knowledge of the needs of people with ID and their families. 2014 highlights included:

- **Continued evaluation of Healthy Communities, including a new qualitative evaluation.** The qualitative evaluation, led by the University of Cape Town, is helping identify key solutions and strategies to maximize future health programming. The University will train local evaluation partners in participating Programs (SO Florida, SO New York, SO Wisconsin, SO Thailand, SO Malawi, SO Romania, and SO Peru). Preliminary results will be ready at the end of 2015.
- **Completion of the Young Athletes Globalization evaluation project.** This evaluation, conducted by the University of Massachusetts Boston, assessed the impact of Young Athletes in different settings in Kenya, Tanzania, Venezuela, Romania, and Malawi. Key results included:
 - Improvements in participants' motor skills, social skills, cognitive abilities, and adaptive skills.
 - Increased understanding of ID among family members and willingness to bring their child with ID into social settings, as well as the development of support networks among parents.
 - Enhanced interaction with and understanding of people with ID by community members, particularly university partners.
- **Implementation of Unified Sports evaluation.** This evaluation has multiple components and aimed to answer four main questions: 1) Does Unified Sports improve social inclusion among athletes and partners as well as in the broader community? 2) Does Unified Sports impact athletes' and partners' health, physical activity, and sports participation outside of Special Olympics? 3) What are the demographics of Unified Sports athletes and partners? 4) What are the current levels of awareness about Unified Sports in the general population and how are Special Olympics' activities affecting these levels?
