



SOKS Rules Modification - Athletics

Athletes must compete in the same event in which they competed at regional.

There is no relay allotment per organization.

Relay alternates (max of 2 per relay team) must keep the original relay team in the same division as they were originally registered. A female may substitute for a male in a male relay division, but a male may not substitute for a female in a female division.

Athletes can only compete in Running or Standing Long Jump - not both.

Athletes must be able to jump 1 meter to enter the running long jump. Running Long Jump, take off board/line is .5 meters from the landing pit.

*Ball Throw for Distance (Tennis Ball) -Athletes with entry scores longer than 15 meters

will be placed in the softball throw.

*Events for lower functioning athletes. Athletes cannot cross over between low motor and non-low motor RUNNING/RACING events. Athletes can only compete in RUNNING/RACING events that have a star by them or events that do not have a star beside them.
