# Run Route Information

Will be starting at 251 N. 10<sup>th</sup>, St. Run  $\frac{1}{2}$  block east to 9<sup>th</sup> St. turn south on 9<sup>th</sup> St. to Ash St. run two blocks east on Ash St. to Santa Fe. Turn south on Santa Fe, run south on Santa Fe crossing Kansas Wesleyan University campus to Cloud St. We will then turn east on Cloud St. and run approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  miles to Ohio St. Turn south on Ohio St. and run approximately 1.5 miles ending at Jerry Ivey Park. Distance is approximately 4.28 miles.
