## Regional Specific Information:

The tournament is tentatively scheduled to begin at 9am. Official start times will depend on the number of participating teams and athletes. A tournament schedule will be sent to you no later than Friday, February 16.

I will email you a list of any athletes on your roster that have expired or non-existent physicals once your registration has been entered. Please have all physicals turned in no later than Monday, February 19.

SOKS will provide lunch for all athletes, coaches and volunteers. The lunch meal will include a Goodcents sandwich, fruit, cookie and water. If you have a gluten intolerant athlete or coach, please let me know ahead of time and we can make arrangements.

There will be a concession stand available throughout the duration of the tournament. As well, many food options are available within Junction City.

The Junction City facilities do not have adjustable rims. Should you have a Level 5 team, we can work together to come up with a solution to provide a fair and fulling game experience for your athletes.

Games at the regional tournament will be played with five minute quarters. This is one minute shorter than state tournament games.

There is no scheduled make-up date for the tournament. In the case of inclement weather, a decision will be made to cancel the tournament no later than Friday, February 23.

Because Junction City High School is not especially wheelchair accessible, I would like to schedule all wheelchair athletes and athletes whose parents or supporters are in a wheelchair in the main gym. Please include wheelchair notes with your registration forms.
