GOLF COMPETITION – Sierra Hills Golf Club will host the 2018 golf competition. Check-in is at 3:30 pm; shot gun start at 5:30 pm. Each two-some (including stroke play athletes) will have their names on the cart when they check-in. The course has a driving range. Coaches should pick up golf awards Saturday, October 6 at TRYC. Coaches are responsible for distributing awards to the athletes.

SOFTBALL COMPETITION – Two Rivers Youth Club (TRYC) will host the 2018 softball competition. Check-in will begin at 7:15 am Saturday morning. A team check-in station will be located just outside the South entrance of the park facility. There are 14 slow pitch teams, 16 coach pitch teams, and 3 T-ball teams. Teams will receive awards on Sunday following their last game.

HOMERUN DERBY COMPETITION – The Homerun Derby is Saturday on field # 5 starting at 12:00 pm. Athletes will be registered as they report to the field. For each coach pitch and/or softball team that has registered, they can have up to 5 athletes compete in the Homerun Derby – i.e. Olathe has 2 softball teams, a max of 10 athletes can compete in the Derby. Only the top three home run hitters from each division will hit in the finals. Each participant will be allowed 5 swings.

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SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT DETAILS

TEAM CHECK-IN – All teams will need to check-in near the South entrance of TRYC. Please park buses and large caravans near the back of the lot.

OPENING CEREMONIES

Opening ceremonies will take place on Field # 2. Teams will be escorted, by a volunteer, inside the field; please have your team line up at the entrance located at either the first base line where a volunteer will provide further instruction. Opening ceremonies will promptly begin at 7:55 am.

SPECIAL OLYMPICS DETAILS

RECREATIONAL SWIMMING – Special Olympics Kansas’ policy regarding the use of the motel pools is as follows:

Motel swimming is not a supervised Special Olympics Kansas activity even though teams traveling to Wichita for the purpose of participating in the State Softball & Golf Tournament are covered by SOKS insurance. It is necessary to comply with the following policies when swimming in motel pools.

1. Each group must have at least (1) certified lifeguard in the pool.
2. For every four (4) athletes swimming, there **MUST** be one (1) coach **in the pool at all times**.
3. Athletes with a history of seizures must have 1-on-1 supervision

SOKS CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ATHLETES AND COACHES – Participants shall not consume alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs while participating in any Special Olympics event.

SOKS MEDICAL/PARENT RELEASE FORMS - Coaches **MUST** have in their possession, at the event, a copy of a current Special Olympics Kansas Medical Release Form for each athlete and a copy must be on file in the Headquarters Office. No Medical Forms will be accepted at the games to register athletes.

ACCIDENT OR SICKNESS REPORTING - Enclosed is a Special Olympics Incident Report form that you need in case of a sickness or emergency. Please complete the Incident Report and the Injury/ Sickness Form and return immediately to the Special Olympics Kansas Office. All athletes, coaches and volunteers are covered by Special Olympics insurance. Additional Injury/Sickness forms will be available at the general store/volunteer check-in area at the entrance of the TRYC Park or at the medical station onsite.

MEDICAL SERVICES – There is medical staff on duty at the State Softball and Golf Tournament. In addition, a first aid kit will be located at each field and is available to coaches for care of minor scratches incurred by athletes during a game. First aid kits will contain a mixture of Band-Aids, ice packs and other miscellaneous quick-fix items for minor injuries.
