Special Olympics Kansas (SOKS) is dedicated to empowering individuals with intellectual disabilities to become physically fit, productive and respected members of society through sports competitions, health and nutrition programs and leadership development.

Offering year-round initiatives to children and adults with intellectual

disabilities, Special Olympics Kansas is a platform for acceptance and inclusion as well as one of the largest advocates for healthy lifestyles in the state – regardless of race, religion, ethnicity or cultural differences.

The Law Enforcement Torch Run® (LETR) is the largest public awareness vehicle and grass-roots fundraiser for Special Olympics. Known honorably as Guardians of the Flame, law enforcement members and Special Olympics athletes carry the “Flame of Hope” into the Opening Ceremony of local competitions, and into Special Olympics

State, Provincial, National, Regional and World Games.

Annually, more than 97,000 dedicated and compassionate law enforcement members carry the “Flame of Hope,” symbolizing courage and celebration of diversity uniting communities around the globe.

Lisa Elsener

Special Olympics Hall of Fame Athlete
& 2018 Lockton Courage Award Recipient



Lisa Elsener has competed in more than 300 Special Olympics Kansas events; and that’s just in the last 15 years. She started figure skating more than 30 years ago and she hasn’t stopped competing since.

Elsener is part of the Johnson County Parks and Recreation team for Special Olympics Kansas and competes in figure skating, speed skating, downhill skiing, soccer, bowling, and volleyball events throughout the year.

“My favorite sport is figure skating” Elsener said. “I like working on the revolutions for the flip jump.”

In February, 2018, Elsener was presented the Lockton Courage Award as part of the annual Win for KC award luncheon.

The Lockton Courage Award is given annually to a Kansas City area female athlete who demonstrates a most courageous performance or comeback in sports.

Elsener was recognized as a lifelong Special Olympics Kansas athlete who has never let anything, or anyone, stop her from accomplishing her goals.

Elsener continues to set and reach new goals each season.

“What I am most proud of this year is landing my flip jump,” she said. “I have been working a really long time to get it.”

Elsener was inducted into the Special Olympics Kansas Hall of Fame in 1990.
